Earlier this year, we began circulating mobile Wi-Fi hotspots. The response has been overwhelming and rarely is there a unit on the shelf. We've recognized their popularity and have added five more to the collection. If you are not familiar, a

mobile hot spot is a device which allows internet access where normally, there may not be. Those who do not subscribe to Wi-Fi at home, or take a vacation or boat trip might find one useful. As long as the device is used

within the US and Sprint service is available, the internet may be accessed. They circulate for 14 days and are non-renewable.
